





### **Assembly of Basic Worbench**

### tach Legs to Wood Top

- 1. Place the wood top on the ground upside down. Use the packing foam to protect the surface when on the ground.
- 2. Place the legs on the wood top as shown and align the edge of the leg flush to the wood top. Center the holes with the holes in the wood top.
- 3. Install 0000327(Screw #14 x 1) using a cordless and a 1/4" driver. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.




## 2 Attach Workbench Support to Legs

1. Align the Workbench Support with the holes on the legs.







### **Assembly of Basic Worbench**

## nal Assembly

- 1. Ensure all fasteners are properly tightened.
- 2. Rotate the Workbench to upright position. Requires (2) people. Do not attempt to tip bench on its side with a single person, as it is unstable in this position and may cause harm to you or damage to workbench integrity.
- 3. Move Workbench to final location. Requires (2) people.
- 4. Adjust leg levelers and legs to desired height. To adjust leg height, see illustration below.
- 5. This completes the assembly of the Basic Workbench.



### **Assembly of Bottom Shelf**

- 1. Position Bottom Shelf over left and right Leg Assemblies. Note, Large single return is placed at the rear of the unit.
- 2. Align holes in Bottom Shelf to holes in Leg Assemblies.
- 3. Install the following and tighten.
- 4. This completes the assembly of the Bottom Shelf.







DETAIL C

### **Assembly of Retainer Lip**

- 1. Position ITEM 2 flush to bottom edge of the top and flush to each end. Mark the holes on the wood top and drill 3/4" deep with 5/32" drill bit. Install Item 2 using the supplied screws(ITEM3). Do not overtighten.
- 2. Position Item 1 flush to bottom edge of the top and with the return lip sitting inside of ITEM 2. Mark the holes on the wood top and drill 3/4" deep with 5/32" drill bit. Install ITEM 1 using the supplied screws(ITEM3). Do not overtighten.
- 3. Repeat Step 2 for opposite End Plate(ITEM 7).
- 4. Fasten the Back Plate to the End Plates as shown in Detail C Using the supplied fasteners, ITEM 6, ITEM 5, ITEM 4
- 5. This completes the assembly of the Retainer Lip.





### **Assembly of Riser Shelf**

- 1. Position ITEM 2 flush to back edge of the top and flush to the edge of the end. Mark the holes on the wood top and drill 3/4" deep with 5/32" drill bit. Install Item 2 using the supplied screws(ITEM6). Do not overtighten.
- 2. Set ITEM 1 on top of ITEM 2, align holes. Fasten panels together using ITEM3, ITEM 4, and ITEM 5.
- 3. This completes the assembly of the Riser Shelf.





#### **Workbench with Drawer Cabinet Assembly Instructions**



- 1 Attach Leg Kit to Wood Top
  - 1. See Page 5, Step 1
- 2 Prepare Drawer Cabinet for Attachement to Wood Top

Remove drawers as need for access to securethecabinet to the top. Note, unit must be in the unlocked position. To remove drawer, extend drawer to full extension. Pull gray lock out on middle slide member, see Fig. 2. Pull drawer out and lift over drawer slide stop as needed to remove. To remove more than one drawer, reach in and push the lock pawl in on the locking mechanism. This may require us of a rod to reach the unit, See Fig. 3 and Fig. 4. To install drawer, reverse removal step. Note when installing drawers, there is no need to reset the locking mechanism or alter the position of the pawls.








#### **Workbench with Drawer Cabinet Assembly Instructions**

Remove knockouts on top of cabinet.

Remove drawers, see step 2. Punch out the (4) knockouts on the top at the outer most corners of the cabinet using a punch and hammer(See Fig. 1). Use a measuring tape and measure the hole pattern from the knockouts. Mark the underside of the wood top to match the cabinet on the opposite side of the leg. Drill a 5/32" hole 1" deep into the wood top.



Install Item D(x4) from the inside of the cabinet up into the wood top using the holes that were drilled in the previous step. Use a cordless drill and a 1/4" driver. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.

Install the drawers that were removed for the top installation.


#### **How to Load**

#### STEP 1.

- Start by loading the bottom drawer first.
- Load the drawer from the back to the front of the drawer.

#### STEP 2.

- Load the second lowest drawer in the same manner as the first.
- Repeat until drawers are filled.





#### **Proper Care**

- Periodically clean the drawer fronts, drawer trim, and other surfaces with a mild detergent and water.
- . Auto wax preserves the storage unit's finish and protects against scratches. Apply the wax as you would on a car.












Do not try to open more than one drawer at a time. Your cabinet includes an anti tip locking device that only allows one drawer to open at a time. Forcing more than one drawer at a time may result in damage.





Do not drop items into drawers, damage may occur.





Do not use drawers as a step, or seat, injury or damage may occur.



### **Bench Uprights Parts List**



BP-UPB48 - Uprights, 48", power plug, for 1.75" butcher block top.

### **Assembly of Uprights**

- 1. Set Upright on bench top with the bracket tight up against the wood top and flush to the end. See Fig. 1
- 2. Using the 1/4" screws, install the screws until tight against wood top. If you have Bin Rails, you can check the spacing of the uprights by installing (1) Bin Rail.
- 3. Using a 5/32" drill, drill a hole 3/4" deep into the top using the (2) holes on the bracket on the top surface of the wood top.
- 4. Install \$100327(Screw #14 x 1) using a cordless drill and a 1/4" driver. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN. 5. Repeat process for remaining upright.
- 6. This completes the assembly of the Uprights.



### **Bin Rail Parts List**



### **Assembly of Bin Rails**

- 1. Install the Bin Rail into the Upright post by choosing the inner most slots on the Upright Post. See Fig. 1
- 2. Push the Bin Rail into the slot, then gently tap the Bin Rail in a downward position until it stops.
- 3. Note, no hardware is needed.
- 4. This completes the assembly of the Bin Rails.



### **Light Frame / Light Parts List**

# **Assembly of the Light Frame and Light Fixture**

- 1. Unfold the Light Frame Assembly until it is a U-Shape.
- 2. Slide over the uprights until the frame is flush with the Upright Post, See Fig. 1.
- 3. Tighten the knob on the back of the light frame, See Fig. 2. Note, the male plug will need to be installed in the upright with the female outlet at the top, see Fig. 1 and Fig. 2.
- 4. Using the 1/4" x 2" screw that is provided with the light, attach the light fixture to the Light Frame crossmember. There are 2 holes in the cross member of the light fixture to attach the light to.
- 5. Clip the powder cord into the plastic clips.
- 6. This completes the assembly of the Light Frame and Light Fixture.




### **Assembly of the Monitor Holder With Keyboard Tray**


- 1. Slide over the uprights until the unit is in the desired position, See Fig. 1.
- 2. Tighten the knob on the back of the unit, See Fig. 1.
- ${\bf 3.}\ Adjust\ the\ tension\ of\ the\ fasteners\ as\ needed\ to\ hold\ the\ Monitor\ and\ Tray\ in\ the\ desired\ position.$
- 4. This completes the assembly of the Monitor Holder With Keyboard Tray.



### **Caster Instilation for Mobile Units**

- 1. After the legs have been installed to the underside of the top, install the casters.
- 2. One leg kit will have the rigid casters installed and the opposite end will use the swivel casters, see Fig. 1.
- 3. This completes the assembly of the casters.


